Updates & Reminders from the Elders:

The Elders, with all in attendance, had an excellent meeting this past Tuesday. After a fruitful discussion, which included input from numerous sources, we moved to the following decision:

- ♦ On Sunday, June 7, we will resume "normal" congregational worship which will include: congregational singing, the Lord's Supper, and tithes and offerings received in the normal way. There will continue to be no choir, no nursery, and no Sunday school.
- ◆ The Fellowship Hall will be set up for use by those who desire to continue "social distancing" and to avoid congregational singing. Officers will walk across the breezeway to administer the Lord's Supper to those gathered for worship in the Fellowship Hall, but a box will be used for offerings rather than a passed plate.
- We are also exploring ways to administer the Lord's Supper so as to be as hygienic as possible. We will have more detailed instructions on this before June 7.
- ◆ Let us restate that no one should feel compelled to come, and some should NOT come:
 - Please DO NOT come if you or someone in your home is feeling ill.
 - Use wisdom and discretion if you are considered "at risk" per the CDC guidelines.
 - If, <u>FOR ANY REASON</u>, you think it is <u>not prudent</u> or you are <u>not comfortable coming</u> at this time, <u>please use the online option</u>.
